



## **Scholarship Guidelines 2010**

Deadline dates for Scholarships is April 01, 2010

The awards listed below are tentative and based on the available funds.

Please Distribute. One does not have to participate in the festival to be eligible for the scholarships.

### **The Michael Harms Memorial Scholarship**

- awarded to a graduating senior only
- can only be used for further education
- distribution of the award will be by check, made out to an institution of higher education.
- recipient must contact the Festival Director with details of further educational plans to initiate disbursement

### **Summerfame Scholarship**

- awarded to an undergraduate (freshman, sophomore, or junior) student who attends high school in the Syracuse City School District
- to be used the summer immediately following the Festival
- includes tuition and room & board
- please make sure those recommended are willing and able to attend
- 2010 dates – July 20 thru August 1

### **Cultural Resources Council- Technical Scholarship- \$600.00**

Awarded to a high school senior who has been accepted into a College or Professional Arts School with a concentration in Theatre Payment will be made directly to the school.

### **Josh Jaquin Memorial Scholarship-\$300.00**

- awarded to a current Junior or Senior
- recipient must play a pivotal role in the theatrical aspects of the production
- exhibit some or all of the following traits
  - o creativity
  - o willingness to work beyond job description
  - o ability to think outside the box
  - o respond positively to problems
  - o positive, friendly attitude
- may only be used for “educational” purposes, including, but not limited to:
  - o tuition, fees, expenses related to college courses
  - o expenses for summer stock or other work/training program
  - o expenses attending national or regional conferences for theater professionals
  - o expenses involved in exposure to significant theatrical experiences
